## **Rains Eye Plan 1780s**

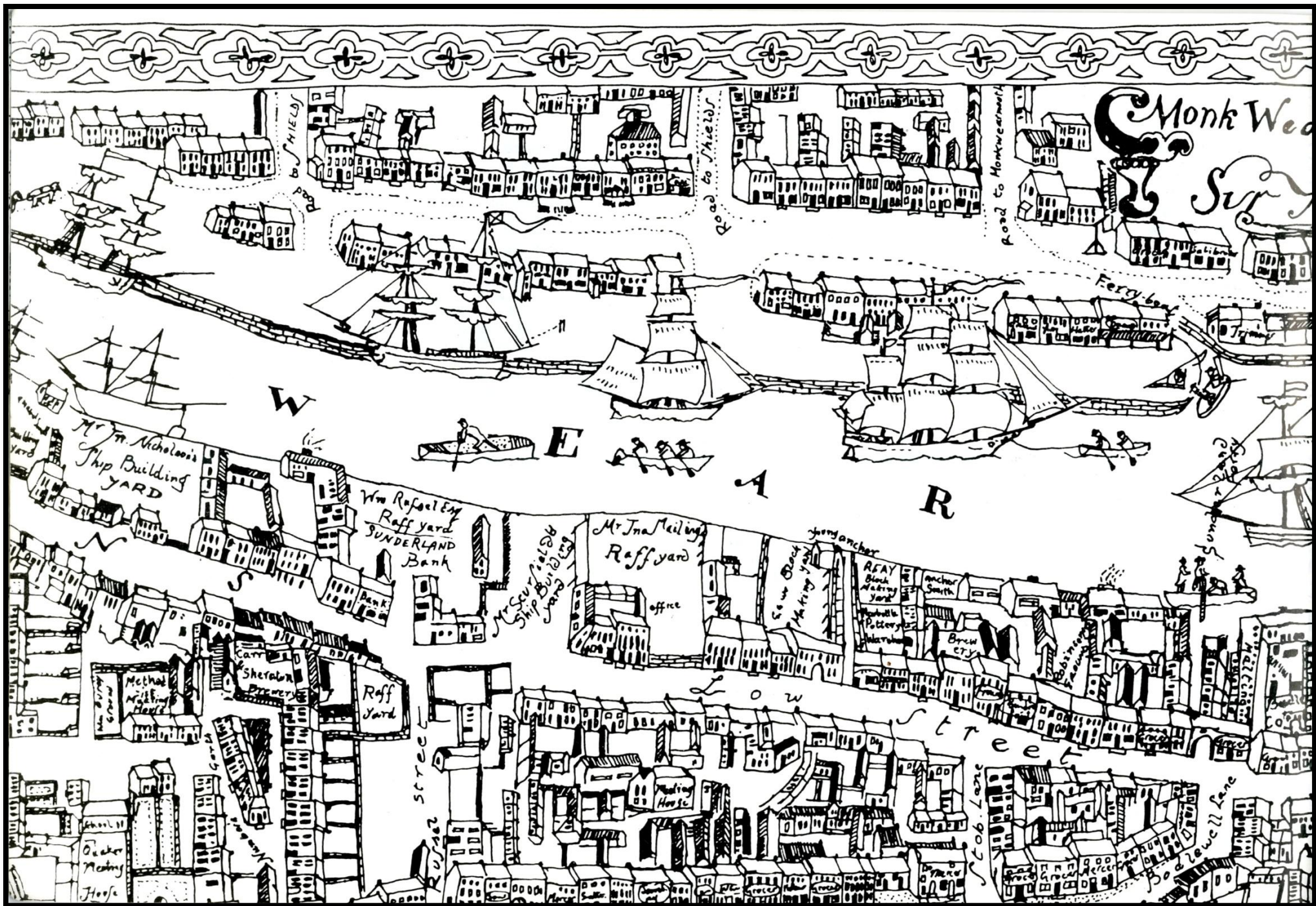
This plan is a unique document, it is a hand drawn plan (not to scale) that depicts the east end and parts of the west end of Sunderland. It provides a visual representation of the town that shows aspects of ship building, housing, social conditions etc. It demonstrates the sharp increases in population and why Sunderland Parish was established as an independent parish.

You can see why the wealthy of this parish would soon move to the West End of Town (known often as the best end) as the population became densely over crowded and consequently many social ills were evident in the east end.

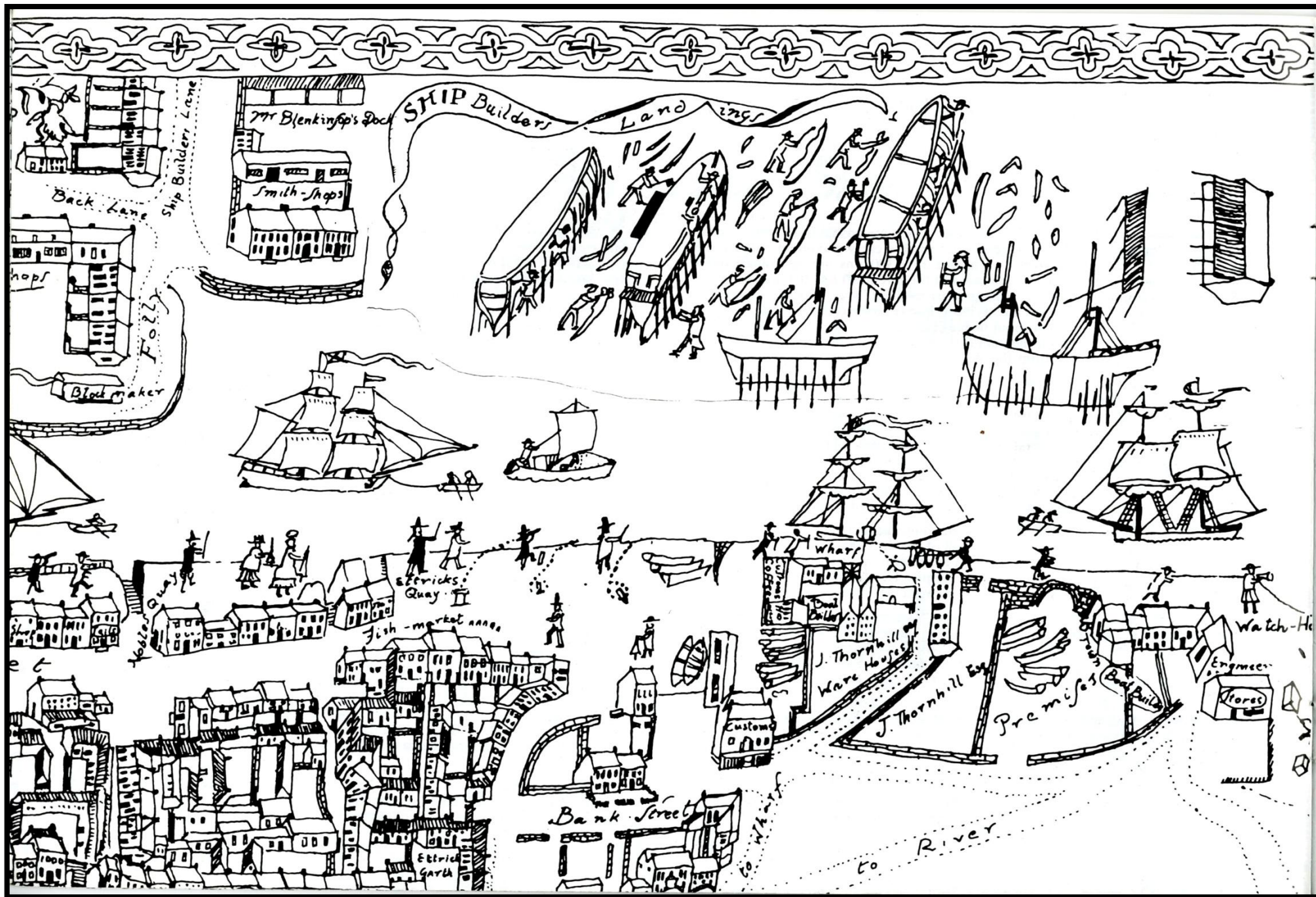

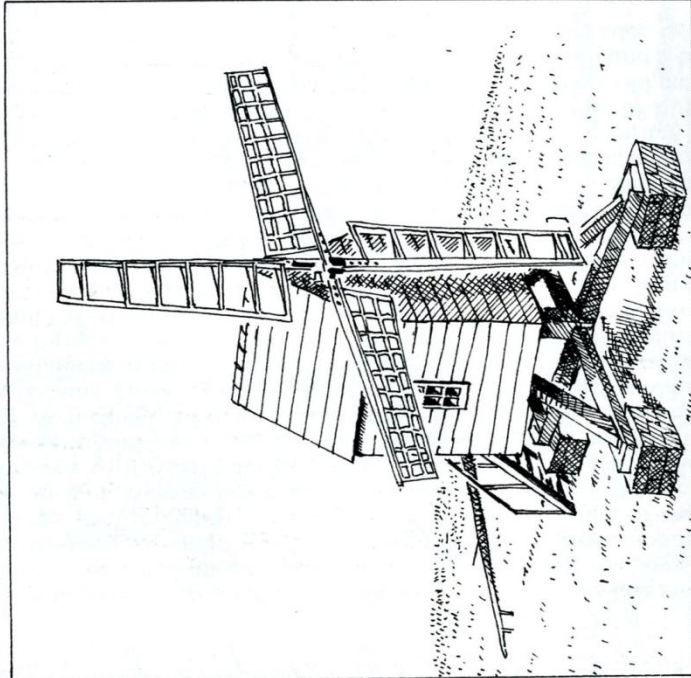
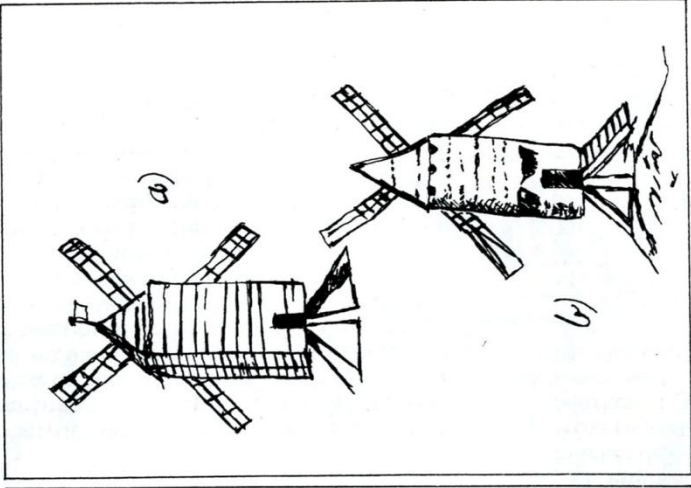


FIGURE 2 POST MILLS:

b) HYLTON ROAD MILL

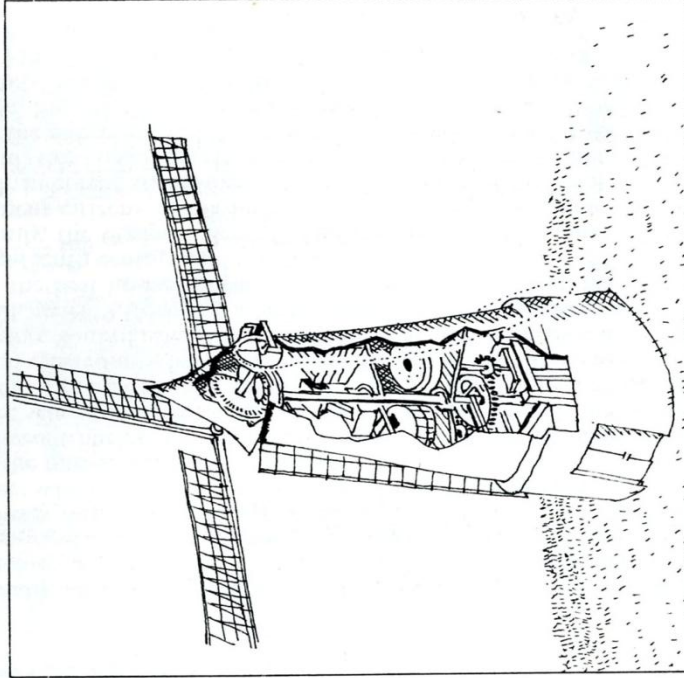
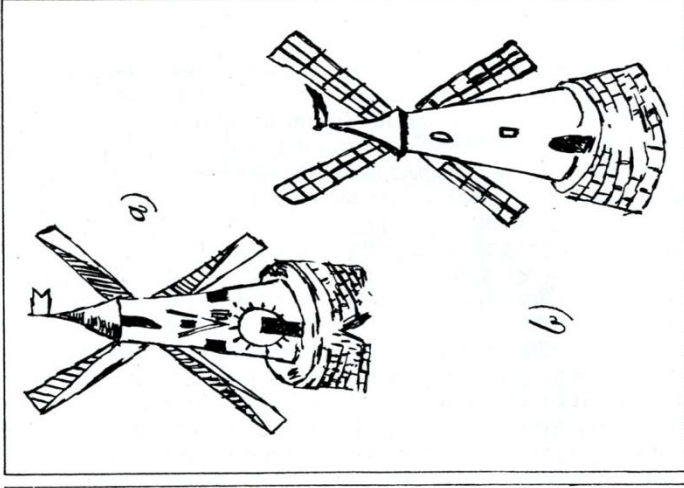


FIGURE 3 TOWER MILLS:

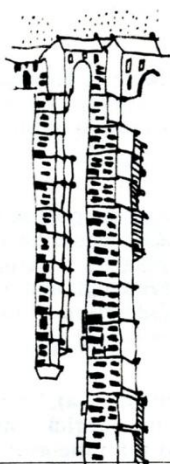
a) DURHAM ROAD MILL



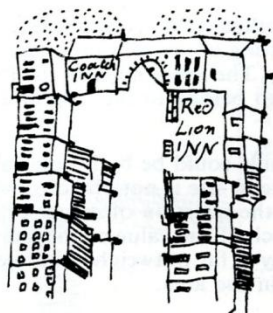
